Recipe of the week!

Crustless Quiche

Ingredients

1 tinned potatoes

Grated cheese

6 eggs

Chopped ham

Tomatoes

Mushrooms

Fry light

Method

- 1. Spray 8inch tin with Fry light
- 2. Slice the potatoes
- 3. Layer the bottom of the tin with potatoes
- 4. Add a thin layer of cheese over the potatoes
- 5. Add the ham and mushroom and some tomatoes
- 6. Whisk the 6 eggs, season with pepper and add some grated cheese.
- 7. Pour in to the tin
- 8. Bake in the oven for 35-40 minutes at 200 degrees
