Year 5: This week, I asked the Year 5s for suggestions for headteacher's certificates.


These two children were spotted by their peers - how lovely!

Jay's Aim By Harry J







Last Thursday, Jay's Aim visited school to teach Year 5 and Year 6 how to do CPR. We learnt that if you do CPR you should do two breaths and 30 compressions. You should make sure you ask for help and ring 999. You need to try and find a defib machine too (there is one on the school house at school and one in the school office).

Theo and I 'shocked' the dummy with a pretend defib which we found really interesting.

From Jay's Aim:

We try to educate as many people as possible about what to do in an emergency; with this in mind, Jay's Aim provides free-to-attend CPR and defibrillator training (known as CPR/AED training) throughout South-West England. Our goal is to train as many young people as possible - and the people who support them - in CPR and defibrillator use, so that they can be confident in an emergency situation.

Environmental Day

Think about which of the five ways to wellbeing each activity meets too!






HeadStart Kernow has created the resource My Brilliant Place to be ME! for the young people of Cornwall.


