Whole class award for great behaviour and showing a keen interest at the Museum.


# **Attendance**

# Mrs Hill's Cooking Club Weekly Recipe

## Jam Tarts

## **Ingredients**

250g Plain Flour

175g Butter

1 Egg

## **Method**

- 1. Heat oven to 180\*
- 2. Mix flour and butter until breadcrumb like.
- 3. Add egg and bring it together to make a dough
- 4. Roll out the dough and using a cutter make 12 rounds
- 5. Grease tins and place in the dough
- 6. Add 1-2tsp of Jam or lemon curd
- 7. Bake for 20minutes






# Year 5

## **New Menu**


We are please to share our brand new menus from Aspens, which will be available after the half term.


Please note, school packed lunch options will not be available for the time being. This may be an option in the near future.


However, there are plenty of delicious hot meal choices to enjoy each day.
