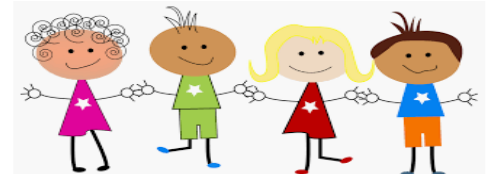

Tilly's Diary

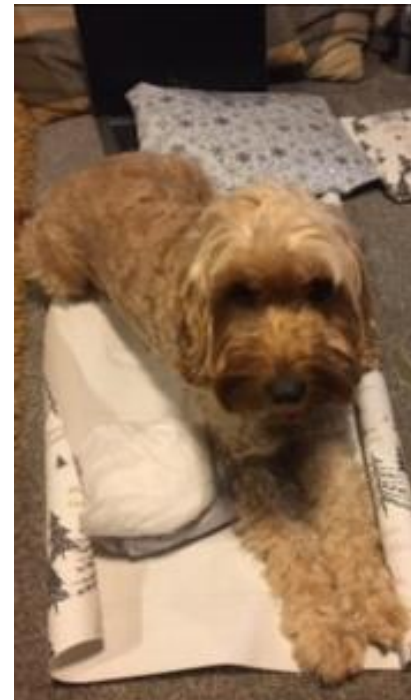
