She is getting super quick at simple mental maths calculations as well as subitising numbers to 6. She can record all the number sentences for number bonds to 5 and understands we can swap addition facts around. Ada enjoys her Maths lessons and always participates. She will even have a go when we do problem solving. Well done Ada! keep up the fantastic work!

Year 1

Congratulations Tymon, We have all worked really hard in maths, doing place value for the whole of the autumn term because we go from counting and knowing numbers to 20 in reception to counting and knowing numbers to 100. Not only counting, but partitioning and knowing the value of the tens and ones, comparing numbers using $<$ $>$ and $=$ and ordering numbers from smallest to largest and largest to smallest. Tymon has achieved every learning objective this term and knows his numbers to 100 with great confidence. He works really hard every day and is able to use his knowledge to solve problems and complete reasoning problems. I'm super proud of Tymon and the consistent hard work he puts into everything. Well done Tymon.

Year 2

Lillie-Ann is such a hard worker and she is always on task. Lillie-Ann always tries her best, even when at times it is really tricky. Please remember to report your child's absence to the school office before 9.00am on each day of absence. This helps us keep an accurate attendance record and ensure the safety of all pupils.

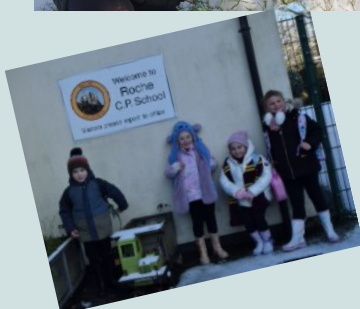
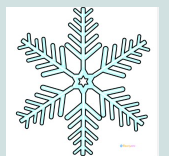
