Smile Together are thrilled to have recently won a contract to deliver a new and significantly expanded Oral Health Promotion programme 'Smarter Smiles' for Cornwall and the Isles of Scilly from January 2024. Over the next three years and working in partnership with our good friends at Peninsula Dental Social Enterprise (PDSE), we will continue engaging with school communities but also vulnerable adults and other groups in need of our intervention right across the county.

Our Oral Health Education programme is an exciting programme set up to teach the children about the importance of good oral hygiene, as well as giving them the opportunity for extra protection against tooth decay by applying (painting) fluoride varnish on their teeth twice in the school year. We will also be providing a home educational pack for children to take home, so you can continue with your child's dental care at home. The packs include a toothbrush, toothpaste, a mini toothbrushing timer and advice leaflets.

We are delighted to be able to deliver our oral health programme in your school community which is part of our commissioned contract with Cornwall Council and is completely free for your child

All our school visits will be in line with current Government and Public Health guidance.
